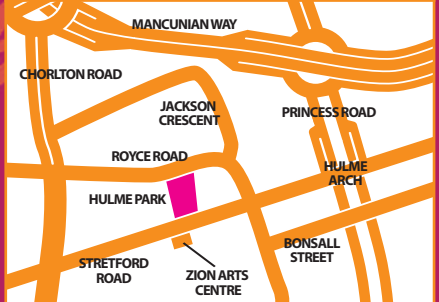
### Exodus Shorts
