Commission: £1000 each (There are two commissions available, £1000 each.)

Art Form: Theatre, Storytelling, Multi art form Theatre.

Eligibility:

- You must be a resident in Greater Manchester
- You must have lived experience of displacement or seeking sanctuary
- You must have the Right to Work in the UK
- This commission is intended for somebody who has experience of making theatre and is looking to develop their creative practice for Manchester audiences.
- This commission is available to individuals or small groups of no more than 2 performers.
- You must be aged 18+

How to apply:

Please submit <u>an idea</u> (in english) by email using the header: **Theatre Commission**. You can submit either:

- A short video explaining your idea (no more than 2 minutes)
- A short description of your idea (no more than 500 words)

You should also include a sentence or two about yourself.

You may also include:

- Information or images of your previous work
- A link to your work on social media or website

About Horizons Festival:

Horizons Festival celebrates the enduring power of creativity by international artists who have made Manchester their home through migration. HOME and Community Arts North West present a provocative and stimulating programme of film, theatre, music, visual art alongside workshops and discussion. Horizons 2024 will take place on **Friday 21 June until Sunday 23 June.**

Horizons Festival aims to:

- To share a wide range of international voices and global issues, through an artistic programme that is accessible to people on different incomes or none
- To question some of the negative ideas about refugees, asylum seekers and migrants that we hear in the press
- To highlight issues that affect refugees, asylum seekers and migrants, and to encourage action

Horizons Festival Theme:

The theme for Horizons festival this year is **Our Planet**, **Our Home** which is an expansion of the National Refugee Week 2024 theme of <u>Our Home</u>. This theme was chosen and created through an open consultation with artists in Manchester who create work relevant to Horizons festival.

Our Planet, Our Home is a way of expressing that no matter what country we come from, we are all citizens of planet Earth - removing the idea of borders and emphasising connection, whilst also holding the importance of nature and climate justice.

About the Theatre Commission:

Your short theatre piece must fit the values of the festival and will be shown as a work- in- progress piece at an informal sharing in Theatre 2 at HOME during Horizons Festival and National Refugee Week.

We are interested in commissions that fit with this year's festival theme **Our Planet**, **Our Home** in your pitch for the commission. We encourage artists to use our explanation of the theme as a guideline and welcome you to interpret it as you wish.

There are **two commissions available**, each commission will receive the following package of support:

- £1000 of funding (£500 in Feb, £500 in June)
- 4 days free space in April at HOME which includes:
 - o 1 x Day of Dramaturgical Support from HOME's Creative Practitioner; Theatre
 - o 1 X Day of Dramaturgical Support from a professional Dramaturg
 - o 2 Days Independent Research & Development
- 1 x Rehearsal and Tech Half-Day in the Theatre on **Thursday 20 June**
- Performance in HOME's Studio Space T2 on the Friday 21 June
- Support with next steps
